WHAT IS ALOPECIA IN DOGS AND HOW CAN I NATURALLY TREAT IT?

Alopecia is the clinical term for abnormal hair loss in dogs. Hair loss can be partial or complete, and while it is sometimes congenital—meaning your dog was born with hair follicles that don't develop normally—it can also be acquired from disease or trauma to the skin.

IF YOU SUSPECT ALOPECIA. ASK YOUR DOG'S VET

Alopecia can be purely cosmetic and not affect your dog's health. However, alopecia can also be a sign of an underlying health concern, so we recommend taking your dog to its vet for a physical examination.

Your vet can perform skin scrapings for parasites, blood tests and skin cultures, allergy testing, and biopsies to rule out causes.

Once the cause is determined, you can work with your vet to best treat the condition. And depending on the reason, taking an integrative approach to treating alopecia often includes natural remedies or supplements.

SIGNS OF ALOPECIA

Hair loss is the main symptom of alopecia, but you may notice these things as well:

- Dandruff
- · Itchy skin
- · Patches of dark skin
- · Brittle or dry coat
- Shedding more than usual bald patches
- Crusting or red patches around the bald patches
- · Inflammation around bald patches

HOW TO TREAT ALOPECIA

Because there are SO many causes of alopecia (think: allergies, poor diet, inflammation from repeated scratching or chewing, fleas, parasites, fungus, autoimmune diseases, thyroid disorders ... and the list goes on!) treating it can be difficult until you know what the root cause is. But the good news is most alopecia is manageable with natural methods.

Changing your dog's diet to include more raw, whole, fresh foods and less processed meals, adding a dietary supplement, changing your dog's environment, and avoiding certain chemicals and drugs can help with managing the condition.
